

# STEP-BY-STEP

### Strategies to Help Children Grasp Sequencing

#### **OBJECTIVE**

The learner will attempt to grow a bean, and write nonfiction work.

#### TIME

Multiple weeks.

#### **MATERIALS**

Copy of *How a Bean Sprouts*, beans, soil, pots, writing and colouring material.

## WARM UP: HOW A BEAN SPROUTS

- Sign in to ABRACADABRA.
- 2. Choose the *Non-Fiction* category in Books.
- Select How a Bean Sprouts from the available list.



- 4. Click on Go.
- 5. Read the story as a class.
- 6. Ask learners:
  - What was the order?
  - What would happen if you skipped a step?
  - Did the author skip any steps?
- 7. Write down their answers on the board.

#### PLANT YOUR OWN BEANS

- Pair off learners. Each pair gets a pot, soil, and a bean.
- 2. Have learners put their names on their pots.
- Ask learner to plant the bean, following the order written on the board (from the warm up discussion).
- 4. Have learners place their beans in a dedicated spot.
- Over the next two weeks, prompt learners to consider if their beans need any care.
- 6. After two weeks are up, have groups evaluate their plants. Did they successfully grow? Why or why not?

#### WRITING ROUTINES

- 1. Ask learners what "nonfiction" means.
- Pair off learners and have them brainstorm activities or routines that are done in stages. For example:
  - Baking a cake
  - Getting ready in the
  - morning
  - Getting ready for bedtime
  - Going on vacation
  - Sitting down for dinner
  - Washing the dog
- 3. Ask learners to write and illustrate their routine.
- 4. When completed, bind the books and ask learners to read them to the class.
