



LETTER SOUND RAP

Blending Words with Songs

OBJECTIVE

The learner will demonstrate they can blend basic words.

TIME

30 minutes.

MATERIALS

Computer with functional speakers, alphabet flash cards.

HEAD CELL

- 1. Sign in to ABRACADABRA.
- 2. Choose the category Sounds, Letters, and Words.
- Choose The Alphabet Song from the activity list.



- 4. Click on Go.
- 5. Pick level 3 and mixed case.
- 6. Point to the letters on the screen as the children are singing.
- If you have a classroom alphabet chart, review the letters and the sounds they make.

CHANT You take a b that's a /b/ and an a – t "at"

You put them all together and they spell bat.

That's bat, b - a - t, bat. That's bat, b - a - t, bat.

You put them all together and they spell bat.

DECODING CHANT

- Pull out the alphabet flash cards. You can find a printable version on the resource page.
- 2. Practice blending sounds together.
- Use the chant on the right to help learners grasp the concept of decomposing words.
- 4. Repeat with a few words.
- 5. Ask some learners to spell words with the flashcards.
- 6. Group children to practice in pairs.
