

LTK+ LOGIN BASICS

Suggestions to Simplify the Login Process

- Use learners' names as their usernames.
Preferably keep this to one word containing few letters (for example, NaomiR). If children share the same first name, include a letter or number to differentiate between them (NaomiA, NaomiB, etc.).
- Use the same, simple password for all learners.
Consider using: 123. This is the simplest password as learners already know the number concept of counting.
- Train students to press the Enter button after typing their usernames and passwords rather than using the cursor. This simple and direct way to log in helps save time.
- Ask Grade 2/3 pupils to show the PP1 and PP2 pupils how to use the computers. Peer tutoring like this helps the younger students build confidence and excitement about using computers. Encourage the groups to try out different games and activities.
- Remind learners of their usernames and passwords prior to any use of the LTK+. If possible, pin their user names in classroom wall for quick mastery.
- Recognize and reward the first and fastest learner to master logging in credentials.
Rewards may include clapping and singing a special song for him/her.
