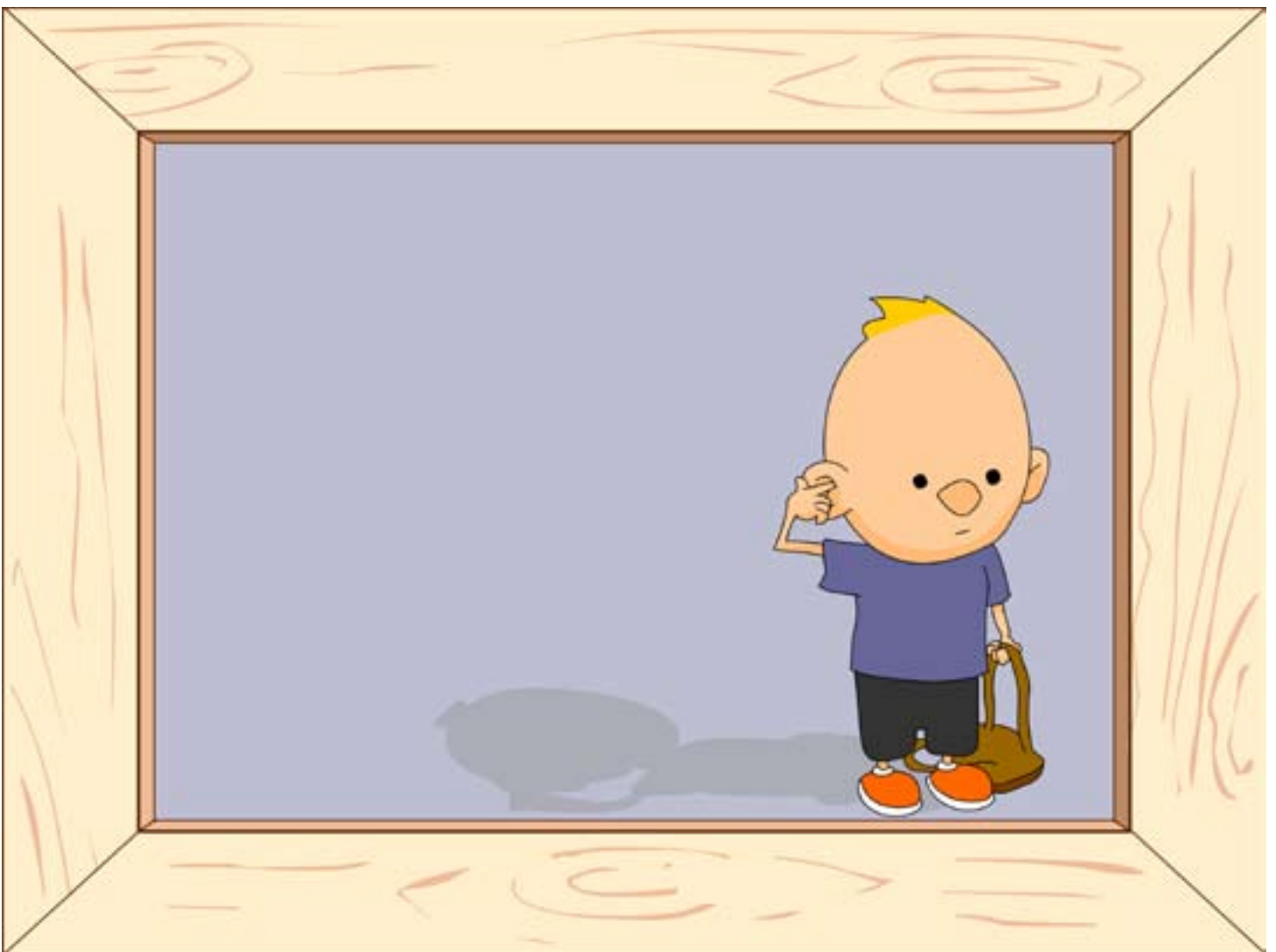
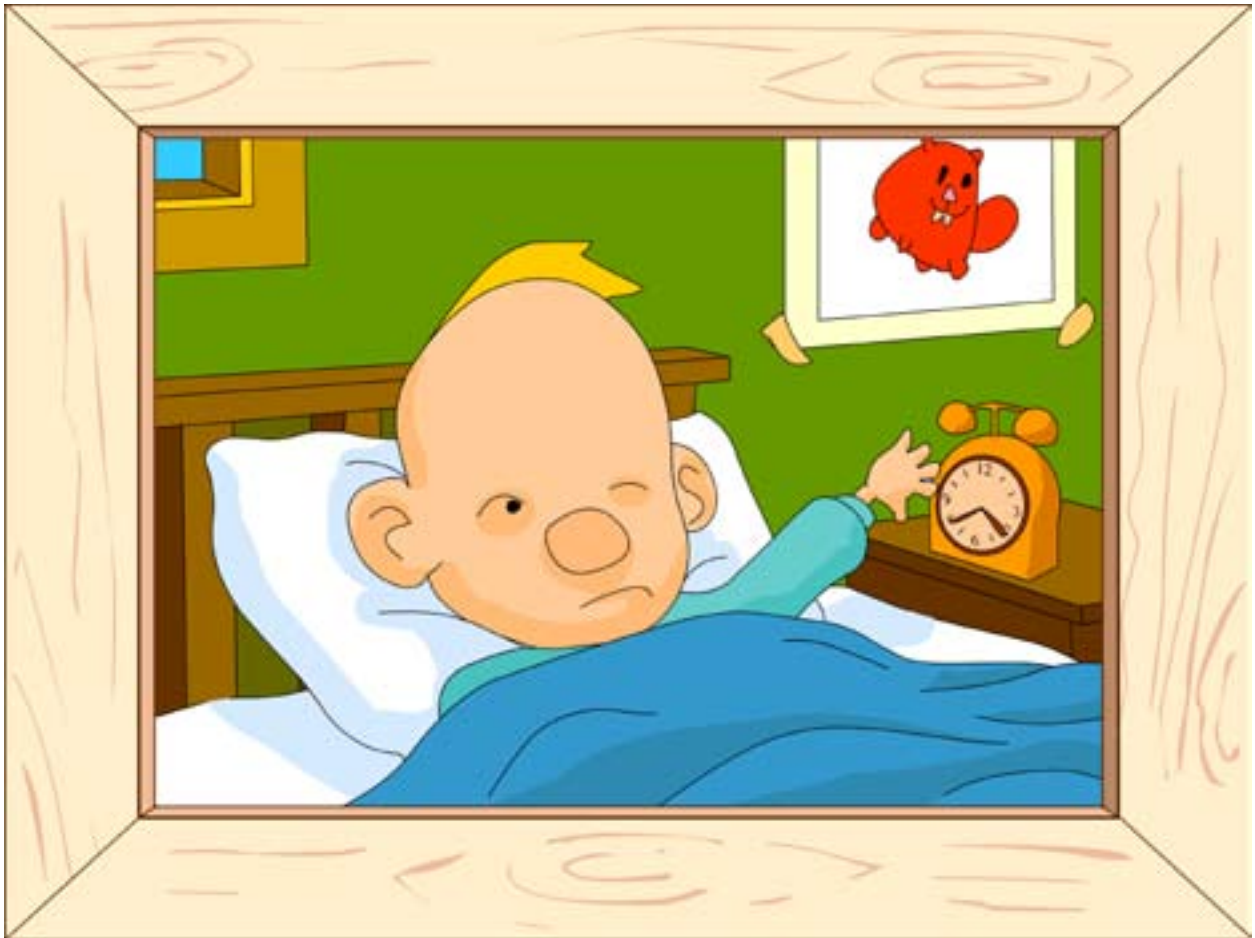

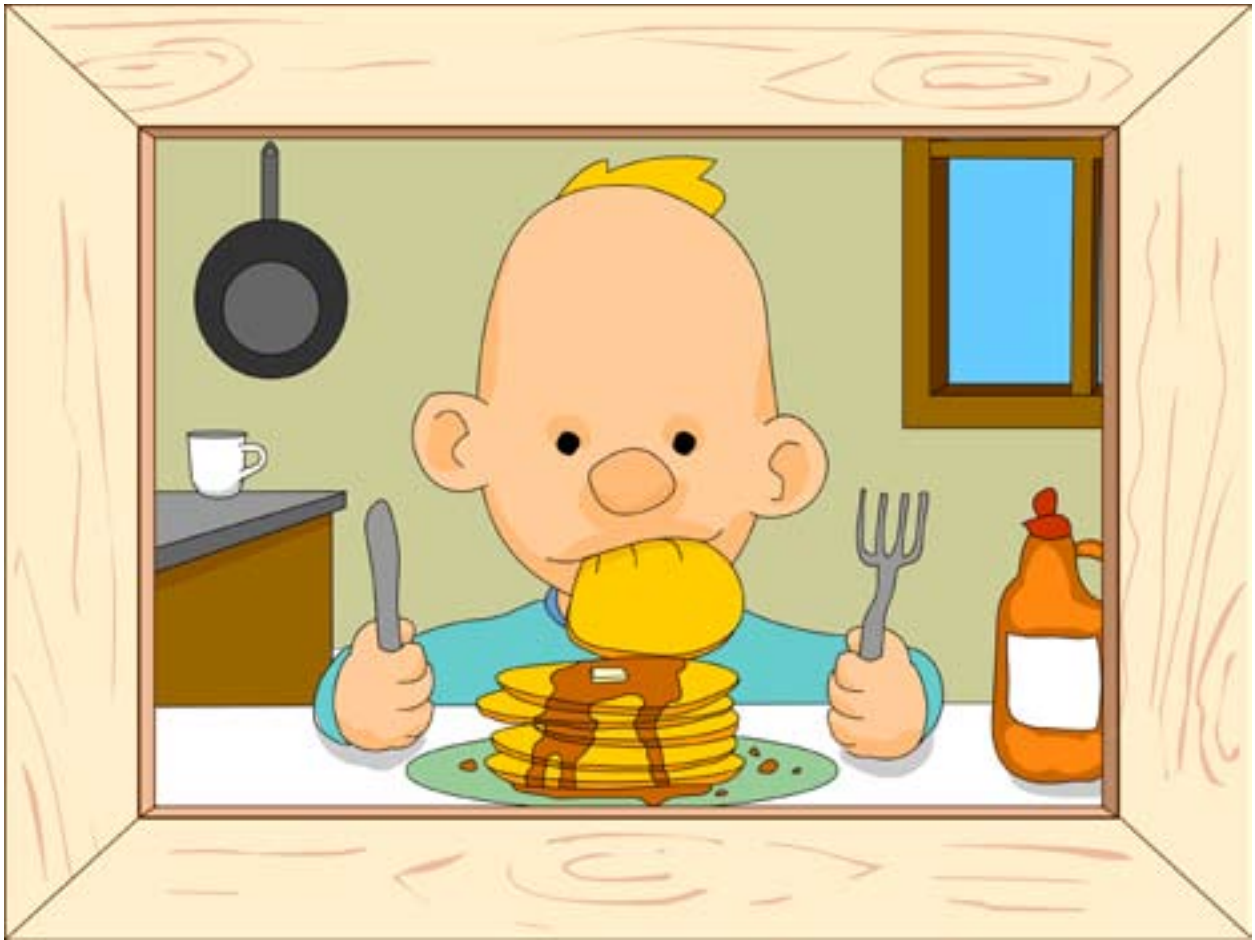

"Delicious." Pancakes with maple syrup.





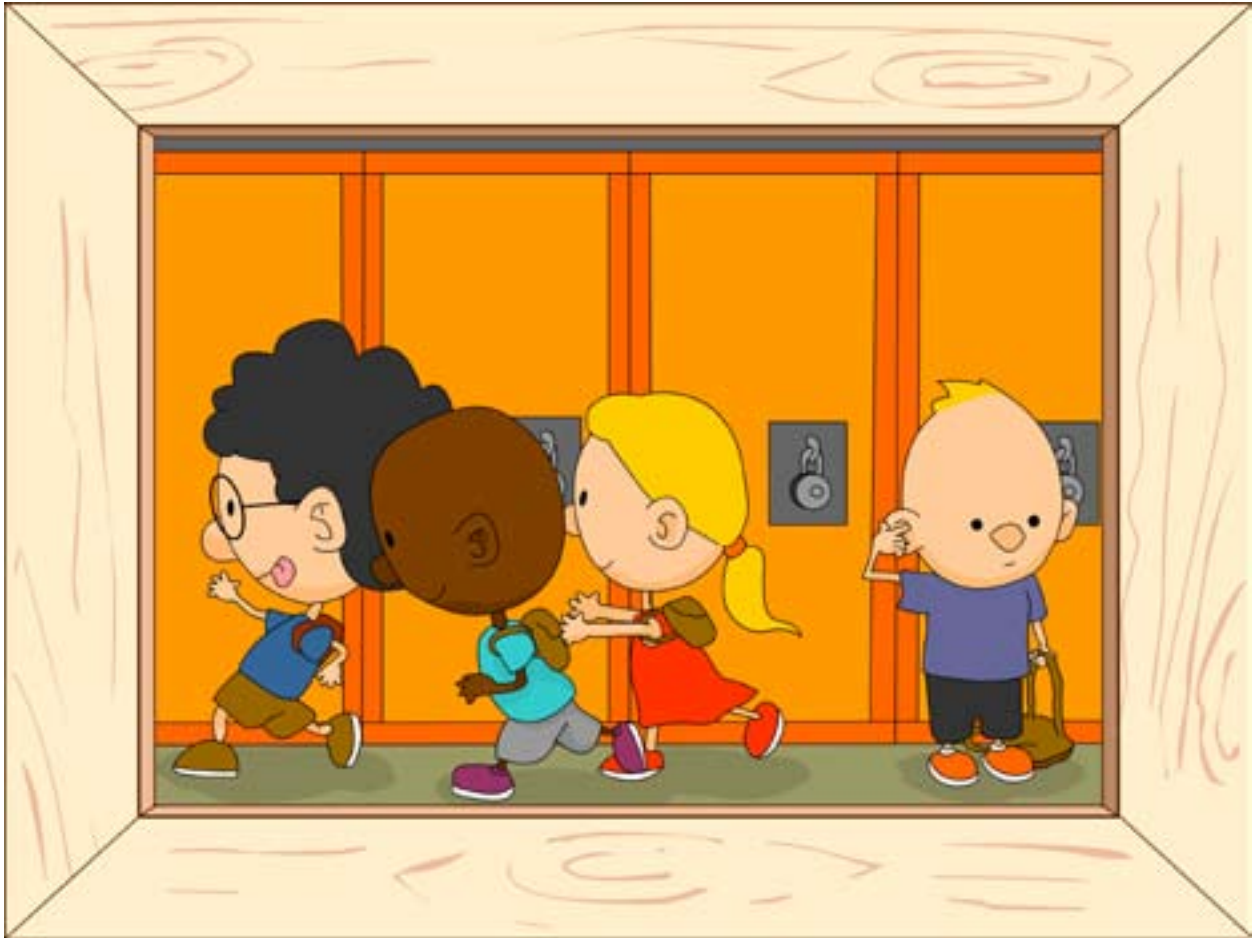

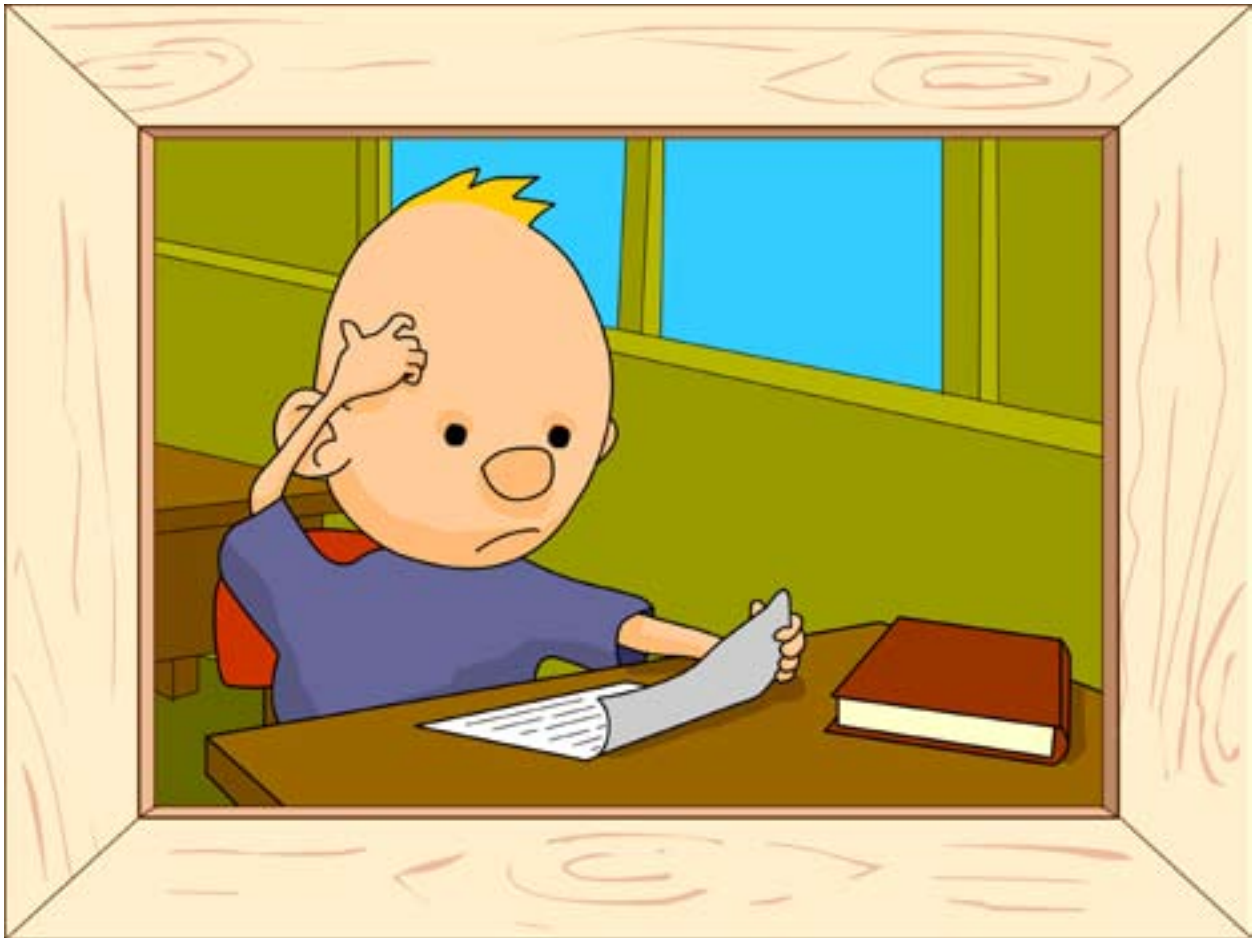
“Dum, du dum, dum dum.” If I could just make that line a little darker.





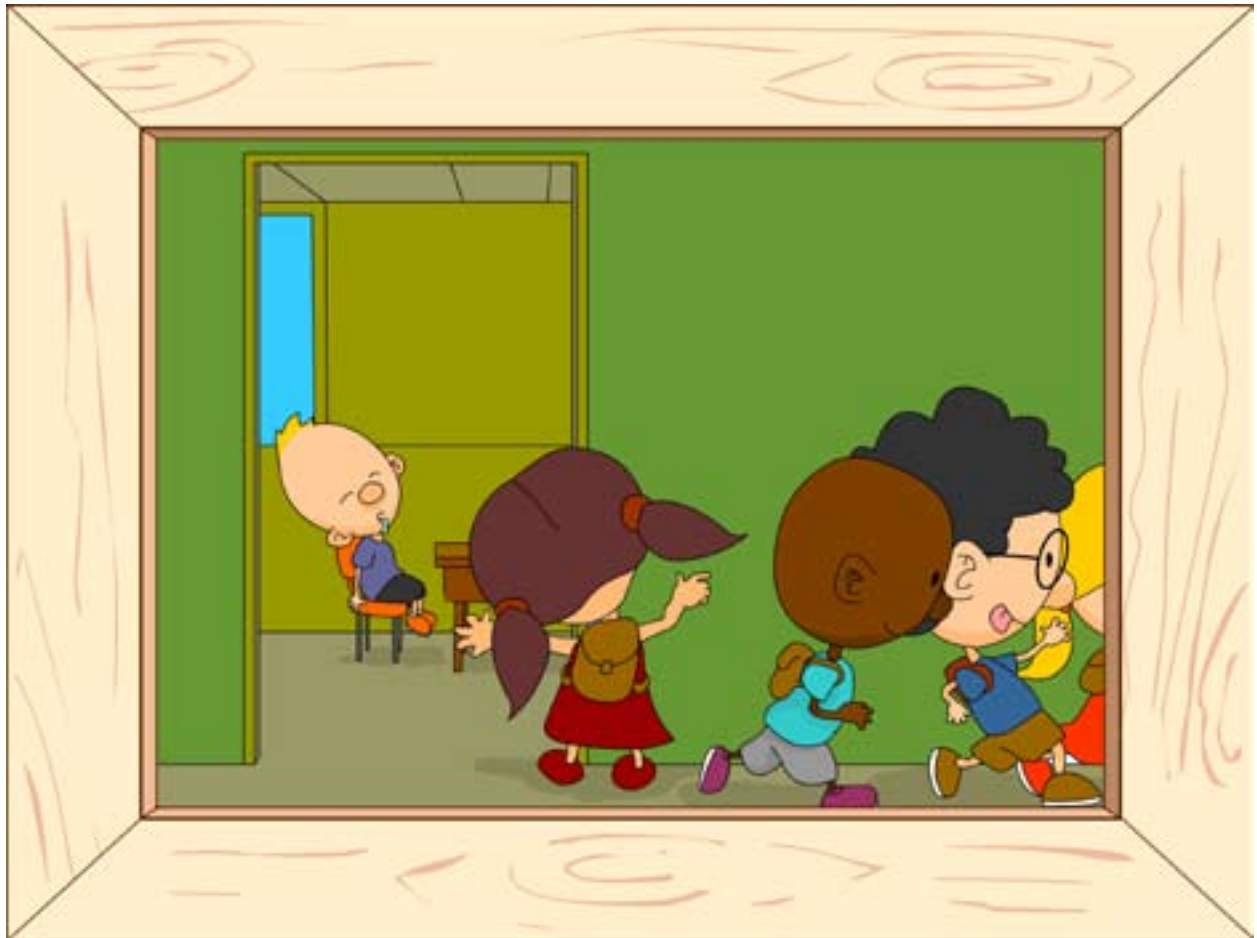
