


Henny-Penny






One beautiful summer day Henny-Penny was cleaning up her yard, minding her own business when an acorn fell and hit her on the head.






"Ouch," she cried looking up. "The sky is falling, the sky is falling. I must go and tell the mayor."

Down the road Henny-Penny met Cocky-Locky, who asked why she was in such a hurry. "I am going to tell the mayor that the sky is falling," she explained.






"Oh my," said Cocky-Locky. "Can I go along with you?"





"Of course," said Henny-Penny, and off they hurried to meet the mayor.






A little farther down the road Henny-Penny and Cocky-Locky met Ducky-Doodle, who asked where they were going.





"We are going to tell the mayor that the sky is falling," they said.






"Oh my," said Duckey-Doodle. "May I go with you?"


"Of course," said the two, and off they hurried to meet the mayor.

"Of course," said the four, and off they hurried to meet the mayor.






"But wait," said Foxy-Woxy. "This is the long way to the mayor's office. I will show you a shortcut," he said with a grin on his face.

They did not realise that this was the hole to Foxy-Woxy's burrow. They also did not know that Foxy-Woxy had not had his lunch!






"I will go in before you and show you the way," said Foxy-Woxy as he went in the burrow. He did not go very deep in to the hole before he turned around to wait for his lunch.





Goosey-Poosey was the first to go in. Goosey-Poosey became the first bite of Foxy-Woxy's lunch.






Duckey-Doodle was the second to go in, and became the second bite of Foxy-Woxy's lunch.






