

SETTING TASK GOALS (LEVEL 1)

In ePEARL, students are asked to set two types of goals: general goals and task goals.

TASK GOALS

A Task Goal--is set when students are asked *What do I want to do?* before starting to work on their task. This type of goal is more specific and is related to the task at hand.

Clicking on the question mark ②, students will be able to read examples of task goals.

Tips you can use with your students:

Before starting to work in ePEARL, teach students how to set goals:

- Reflect with them students about what they want to accomplish when the work is done
- Show examples of what a good task goal can be: "Learn how to spell three new words", etc.
- Bring your own experiences about setting personal task goals to accomplish something as an example for your students.
- Apply "SMART" goals with your students:
 - Specific
 - Measurable
 - Attainable
 - Realistic
 - Timely
- After your students have finished their task in ePEARL, ask them to read again their goals and to reflect on them. You can ask: Did they accomplish what they had hoped to? How could they improve the next time?
